

# WEAVING WISDOM

Two pieces of Wisdom for Inter faith week:

November 11<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup>

In 2014 an inter faith group in Bradford (Touchstone) launched a project to help women from different traditions, in the UK and in Pakistan, to talk about and share their thoughts and experiences of matters of life and faith. Each group



considered questions around wisdom and faith, and in the light of their conversations, each group was provided with materials with which to make a **rug**. These rugs have formed a '**Weaving Women's Wisdom**' Exhibition, which has toured the UK, including the House of Commons.

**The exhibition of rugs** will be on display in Preston Minster during Inter Faith week: Monday 12<sup>th</sup> all day; Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> from noon; Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> from noon; Friday 16<sup>th</sup> all day; Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> all day. Parts of the exhibition will also be used as a backdrop for an evening of open discussion: "**Cultures and Cotton, Faith and Wisdom**". This will begin with a look at the link between faith communities and the local cotton industry, and then move to a sharing of the ways in which Wisdom is portrayed, perceived and experienced in different religions.
